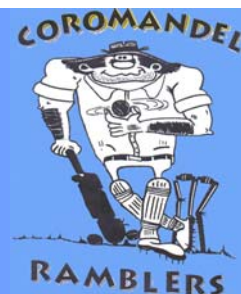

We encourage players from all other grades to come and watch the game, enjoy a BBQ and drinks and help make this a real Club social occasion. Family and friends are more than welcome!

## 20/20 Competition

The first 20/20 match will be held at Hawthorndene Oval on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> November 2005, between Teams 1 (Strange's Strikers) and Team 2 (Mayes Maulers). Subsequent matches will be held on non-selection training nights.

Entry Fee is \$10 per player and includes a free team shirt.

You will be given a handout detailing the teams and dates of matches – please ensure you notify your 20/20 Captain if you are unavailable for a game.

### Rules

Maximum 20 overs or 70 minutes (first batting side) – second batting side receives equal number of overs. All players on list can be used but a maximum of 11 players on the field at any time.

Maximum of 4 overs for first 3 bowlers then maximum of 3 overs for remaining bowlers.

All overs to be bowled from Joan's Pantry end.

Maximum of 2 fielders on boundary in overs 1-6.

Maximum of 5 fielders on boundary in overs 7-20.

Maximum of 5 fielders on leg-side.

90 seconds maximum time allowed for next batsman to arrive at wicket.

5 minute change-over of innings.

All wides and no balls – next delivery is a free hit.

In the event of a tie – team with least wickets lost wins match. If still equal winner is team with most runs after 10 overs, 9 overs etc until a result is determined.

## Message from the Coach

### Welcome

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome the new players to the Club and the return of some veterans. With 5 teams, we are able to cater for players needs and wide range of skill level.

New players are: Chris Leek, Tom Haegi, Dave Benson, Dyllan Smith, Tom Jeffries, Simon Baker, Karl Johncock, Andrew Reavely, Shaun Herbert, Brett Evitt, Dean Howell, Matt Wagner and Shane Kennedy. In the return of veterans I include Phil Mayes, Simon Work, Wayne Jones, Peter McGinn and Karl Gill. I would like to also welcome back Robin Gross after the Archilles tendon injury he suffered last season playing NETBALL [to keep fit for cricket].

### Practice

The weather has been very unkind so far. Practice is scheduled for Wednesdays BUT should it be raining, we will re-schedule for Thursday. I am most appreciative of the assistance that Scott and Brett give me... thanks guys.

Fielding - I have varied the fielding drills... I hope you enjoy the variety.

Batting - we will have 2 nets and the centre wicket now that we have daylight saving PLUS the batting drill of hitting the ball through the cones.

Please stretch and warm up before practice BUT more importantly, cool down after to get the lactic acid out of your body... this will help your recovery and keep you playing longer.

### Congratulations

Luke Scrivens has taken on the role of Captain of our 5th side. Luke volunteered for the position and so far has done a good job. This young, inexperienced side should soon have success especially with the support of additional senior, experienced players.

### Advice

Should any player need advice on how to improve their game, please see me OR talk to one or two of the many experienced players at practice. If you need advice on the rules of the game, please see me.

### Tips when batting

Every ball you face, call loudly and clearly [even if you do not hit ball], " yes / no / wait". Do not say "go" as it sounds like "no". Run the first run quickly, do not amble [your hustle could cause the fielder to miss field]. When you get to the other end, ground your bat, face the fielder, and take a few steps down the pitch in readiness to take another run. Call "yes/no". In your final run, slide your bat and run past the stumps. [Many players only attempt to run to crease].

Try to play in the 4 "zones" [if you don't know what I'm talking about, ask me] eg only cut when the ball is really wide of you and you move your right foot across [RH]. Don't cut if the ball is on stumps, going down leg-side or in the position you should be driving etc.

Move your feet to the ball... your hands will ALWAYS take the bat to the ball, so you will get edges etc. By taking your feet to the ball, your head and body will be over the ball, thus keeping it on the ground.

Actions speak louder than words... take this advice and actually do it!

### Finally

We are into our 3rd game [as I write this] so I hope you are achieving the goals you set for yourself at the beginning of the season. Remember to MEASURE your performance weekly. Good luck!
