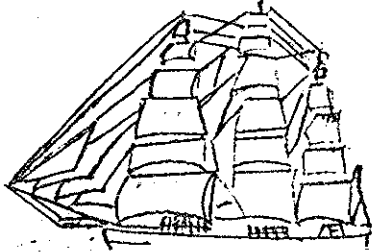

Congratulations to Malcolm Lincoln on winning the Glen Watchman clubman award. This award is given for service to the club both on and off the field. This year it is Harry's turn. Malcolm first joined Ramblers in 1971. Since then, his on field achievements have been extensive. 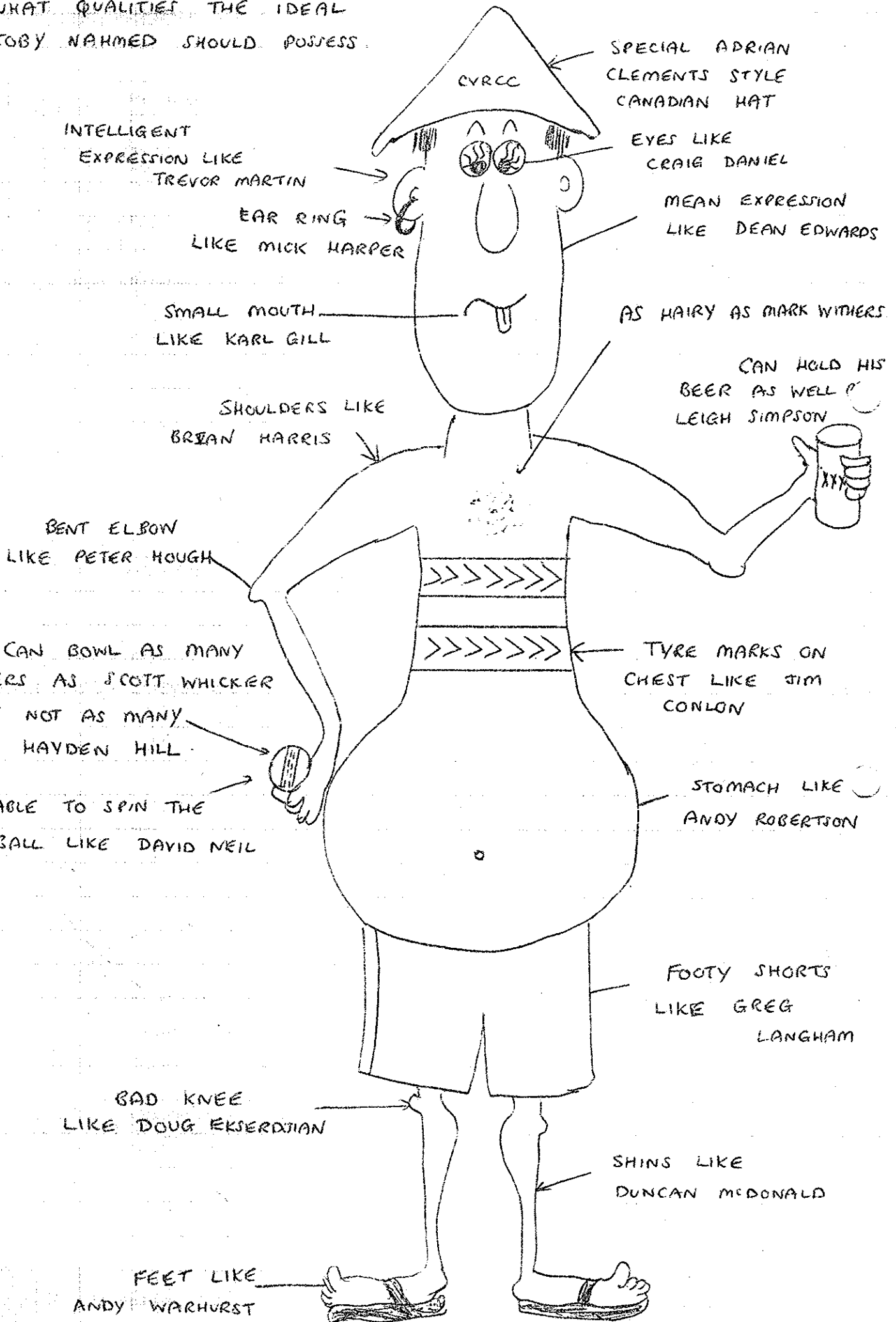
